A brief description of the Ocean Park Association standing committees:

ADMINISTRATION & FINANCE

Develop and review annual budget, investments, audit review, and capital expenditures.

DEVELOPMENT

Promote the growth of volunteer and financial resources through planned giving, endowment, memorials, annual fund, capital funds, and fundraising.

EDUCATION

Develop and coordinate educational programs and events, and oversee the Library Sub-Committee, Arts Sub-Committee, Historic Preservation Sub-Committee.

ENVIRONMENT/NATURAL RESOURCES

Educate about the environment and natural resources available in Ocean Park. Work in concert with the OPA Executive Director to oversee all parks, marshes, and open spaces owned by the OPA and determine maintenance needs. Serve as an advocate for improvements to the beach and other publicly owned natural resources.

LEADERSHIP/NOMINATING

Implement leadership development and training. Identify and solicit candidates to serve on the Ocean Park standing committees as well as Committee Chairs, Board Members, and Member at Large.

PROPERTY

Inspect and determine the necessary repair and maintenance of all OPA owned buildings. Work in concert with the OPA Executive Director to establish current and long-range planning for the continued maintenance of all OPA owned buildings.

RECREATION

Develop and coordinate educational programs and events, and oversee the Tennis Sub-Committee, Youth Recreation programs, and Shuffleboard courts.

RELIGIOUS & CULTURAL

Plan, develop, and coordinate the religious and cultural programs including the Temple worship, Illumination Night/Strawberry Festival, and musical performances.
