**Small Boy Pete's**

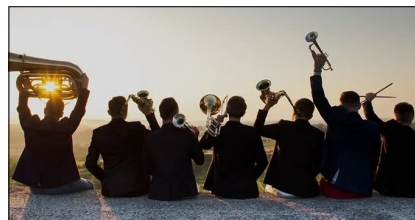
